Our NAWIC Chapter 96 sponsors a FREE program for elementary school children (1st-6th) to learn about the construction industry. The students, working independently in each grade group, use 100 Lego-like building blocks, string, cardboard, one rock, and foil to build something related to the construction industry (no people or animals). All materials are provided. After the projects are built, the students discuss their projects with the judges, who are local construction business people, owners, and architects. Prizes are awarded: Third Place Overall is \$10.00; Second Place Overall is \$15.00; First Place Overall is \$25.00. Also, one child from each grade will be awarded \$10.00.
